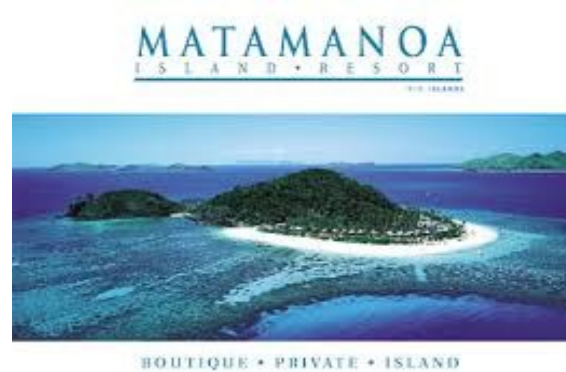
- ✓ those affected by poverty
